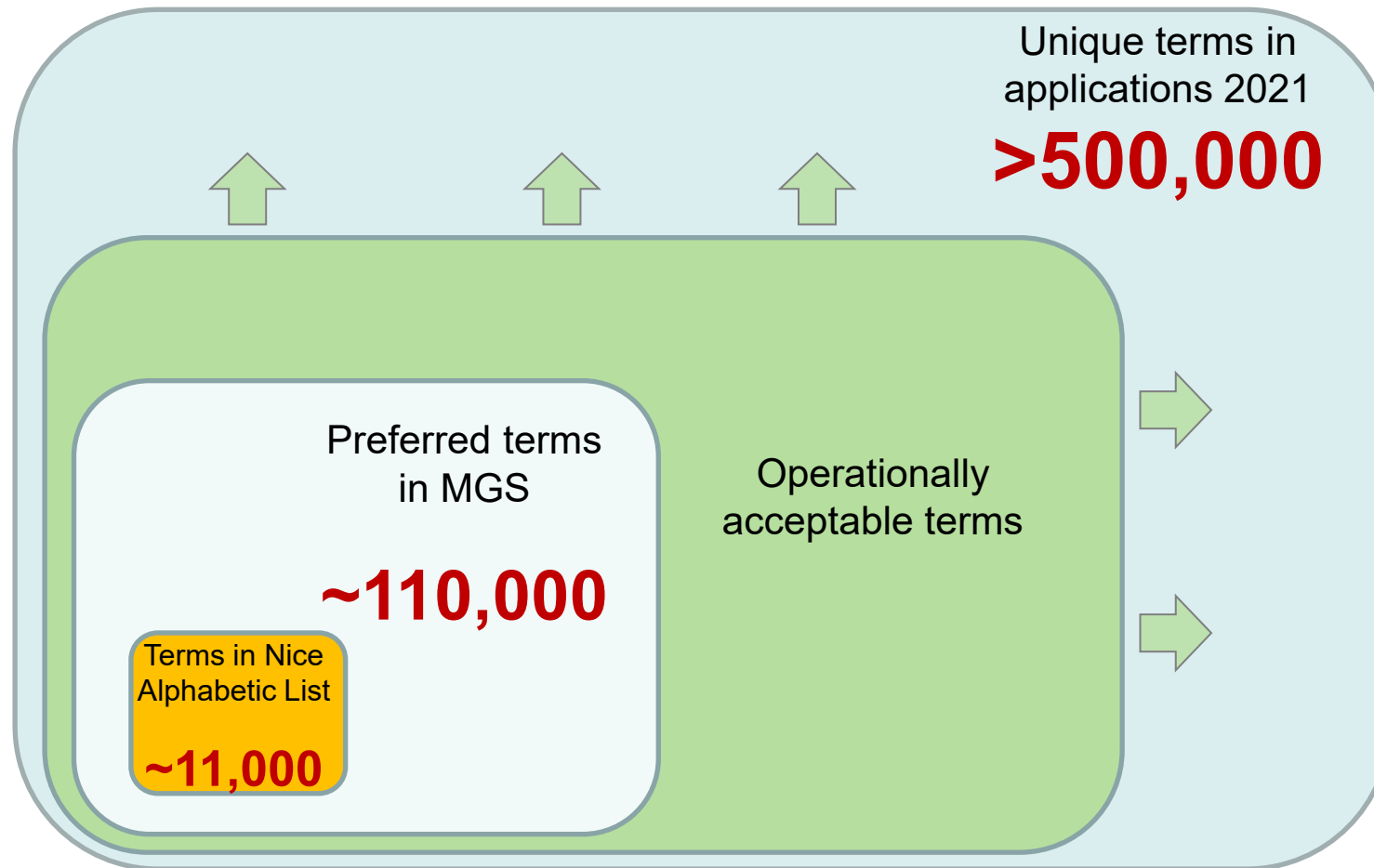
Classification Challenges

- Classification requires expertise
- It is time consuming to determine correct classification
- Repeated efforts for similar terms
- Maintaining consistency between different examiners
- Variations for how terms are expressed
- Differing linguistic approaches
- New and emerging terms

Operationally acceptable terms

- MGS contains preferred terms
 - Aimed to support users in compiling lists of G&S
- Operationally acceptable terms database
 - Includes terms and variations which are considered acceptable by Madrid Operations classification experts
 - Aimed to support IB to perform classification examination
- Project to increase number of operationally acceptable terms
- Reconcile internal decisions with MGS to ensure consistency

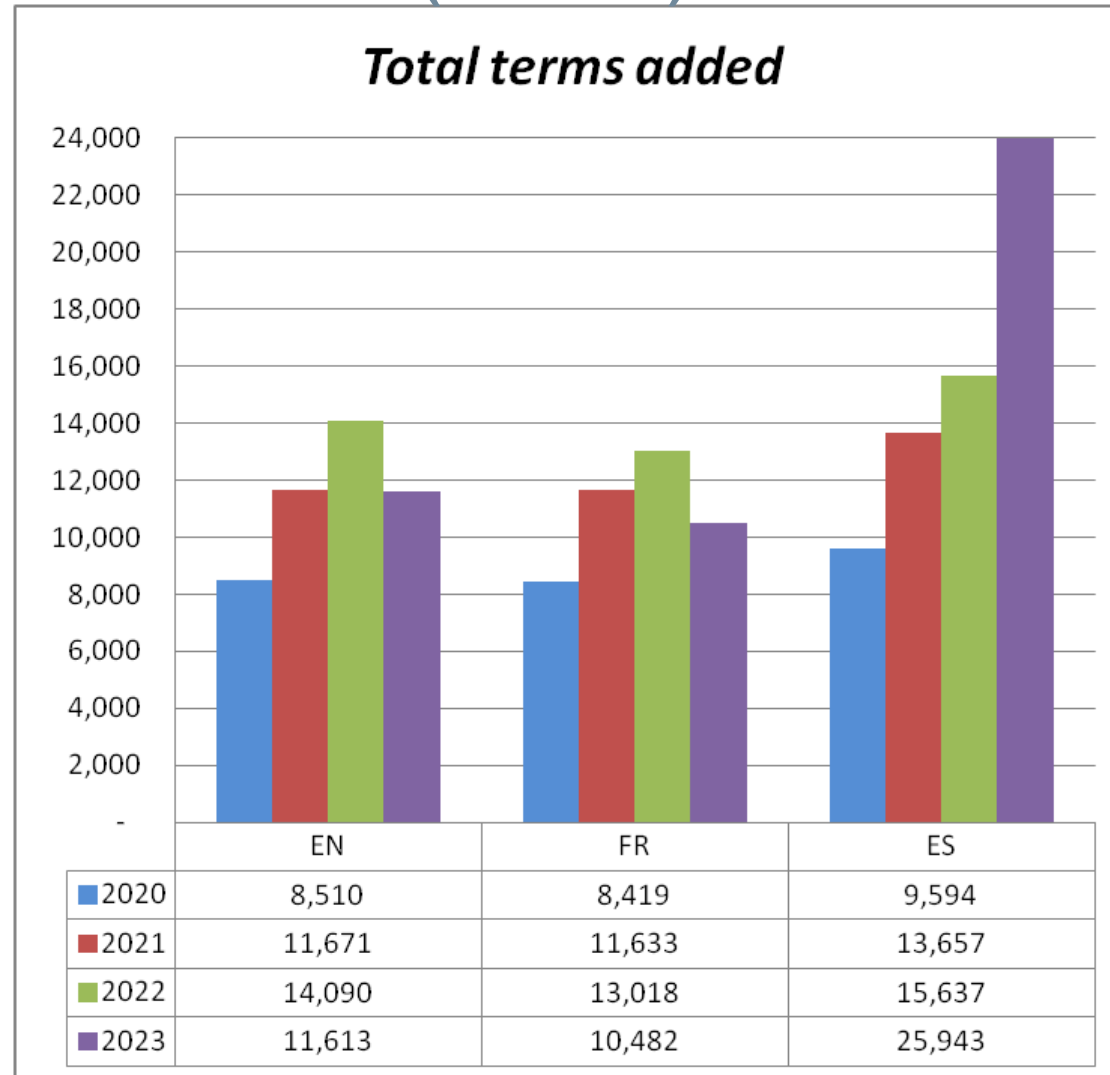
Updates of Madrid Goods and Services Manager (MGS)

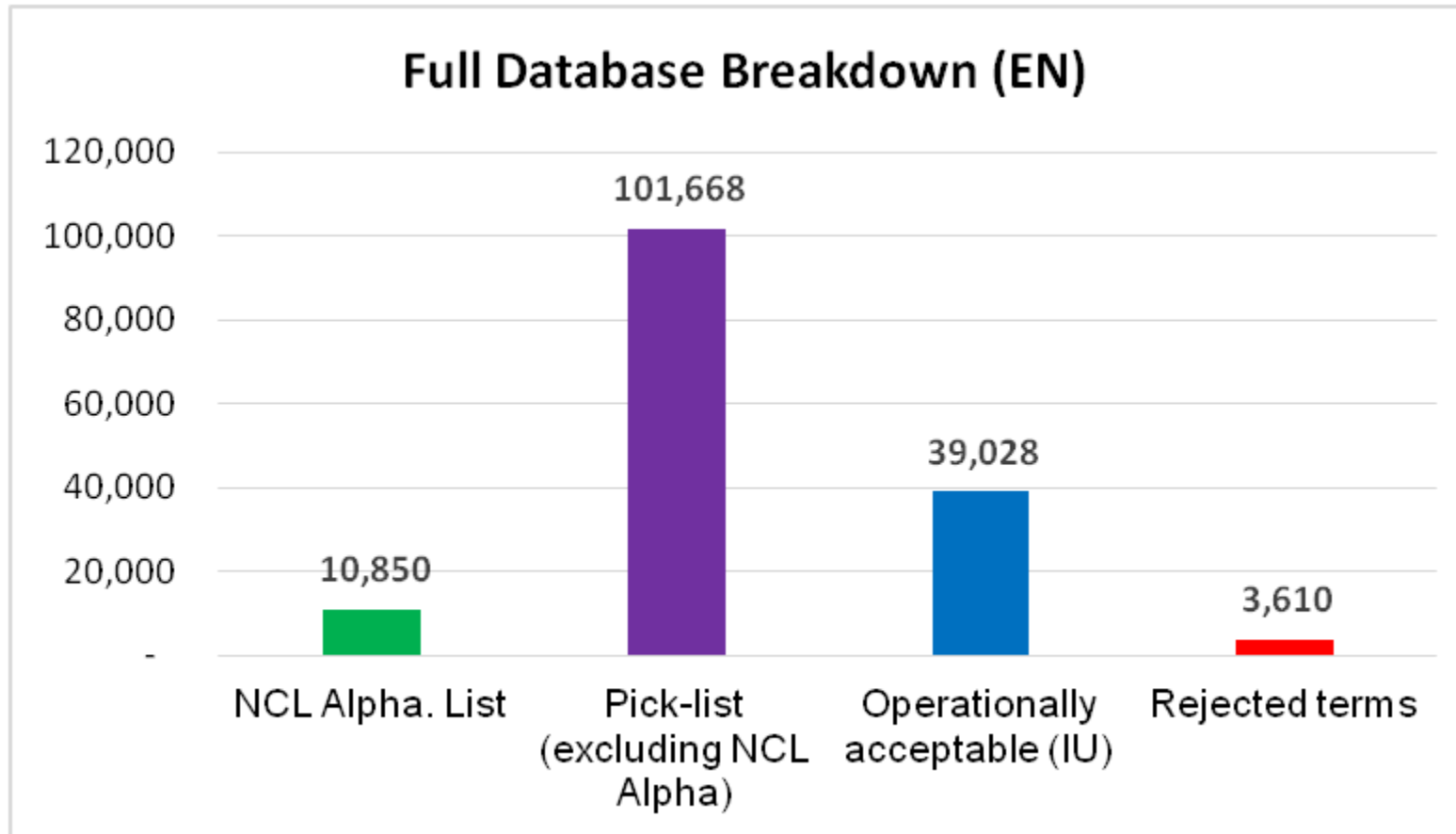

Informal Roundtables on Classification of Metaverse-related Terms

- Observed an increase in new terms and concepts being used in applications
- Particularly in relation to more applications related to virtual goods being received by the IB and member Offices, such as:
 - Non-fungible tokens (NFTs)
 - Metaverse
 - Crypto-related
- There are challenges in classifying these new types of terms consistently.

Informal Roundtables on Classification of Metaverse-related Terms

- Three informal roundtable events were organized between 2022 and 2023.
- Participation of:
 - Experts from seven Offices:
 - CNIPA
 - EUIPO
 - IPI (CH Office)
 - IP Australia
 - JPO
 - KIPO
 - USPTO
 - Experts from industry sector

Informal Roundtables on Classification of Metaverse-related Terms

- Lists of terms related to Virtual G&S, metaverse, NFTs and crypto-related G&S were distributed prior to roundtable events.
- The informal roundtables provided opportunities for Offices to:
 - Share their current classification policy and practice.
 - Consider and discuss their approaches to the lists of terms related to virtual goods and services.
 - Hear the perspectives of industry experts.

Informal Roundtables on Classification of Metaverse-related Terms

- Outcomes:
 - Very few differences in practices were identified between Offices and the IB approaches regarding how such terms should be classified.
 - General consensus that the type of virtual goods need to be specified,
 - Although some differences in how to specify them between Offices.
 - General agreement that it is necessary to specify the individual goods authenticated by NFTs, as NFTs are not stand-alone goods.
 - General agreement that crypto-related products should not be accepted as stand-alone products.

Informal Roundtables on Classification of Metaverse-related Terms

■ Outcomes:

- Participants expressed strong support to the IB's coordination role in promoting information sharing and practice alignment.
- Inclusion of these terms into databases should be explored to support operations teams and customers.
- Further informal roundtables could be considered for other new or emerging terms, including involvement of more Offices.
