WIPO Standards



 WIPO Standards are expressed in the form of recommendations and are directed to <u>States</u> and international organizations, in particular to their national or regional industrial property offices, to the International Bureau of WIPO, and to any other national or international institution interested in industrial property documentation and information.



WIPO Standards (cont)

WIPO Standards <u>facilitate</u> the <u>harmonization</u> of practices by industrial property offices regarding <u>electronic</u> data processing in respect of the procedures for <u>filing, examination, publication, granting</u> <u>and registration</u> of industrial property titles.





WIPO Standards (cont)

WIPO Standards also facilitate the international transmission, exchange, sharing and dissemination of industrial property information (text and images), as well

as access to and retrieval of this information.
