

Madrid Agreement and Protocol Concerning the International Registration of Marks

New Layout of Certificates of International Registrations

1. As from July 4, 2013, the layout of certificates of international registrations effected under the Madrid Agreement Concerning the International Registration of Marks and the Protocol relating to that Agreement will significantly improve.
2. Holders of international registrations will find the reproduction of the mark prominently displayed as the first item on the certificate. Moreover, the bibliographical data will be presented in a single column. Furthermore, the certificate will feature a new font and introduce other formatting changes which will align it with the corporate identity of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) while making it easier to read.
3. A sample certificate featuring the new layout is reproduced in the Annex to the present Information Notice.
