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A- Copyright registration and recordation:

- 1. The registering body in Saudi Arabia is The General Directorate of Copyright which is related to the Ministry of Culture and Information.
- 2. It has other subdirectorate such as:

Department of copyright of publication.

Department of Copyright of Non Printed Materials.

Department of Copyright of Computer Programs.

Department of Copyright of Arts.

- 4. The copyright registering is interconnected to the Legal Deposit Law.
- 5. Copyright Law and Legal Deposit Law
- 6. The kinds of Copyright works include: Books, Periodicals, Audio Visual materials, Computer Programs and Art works.
- 7. Yes, All kind of copyright works can be registered and recorded in the specific department.
- 8. Yes, transfer and licensing of copyright rights with a permission from the owner of original material.
- 9. Yes, there is possibility to record the security interest in the copyright.
- 10. The registration of materials can help in providing of the copyright and recognition of creations.
- 11. The copyright registration and recording is mandatory in all circumstances mentioned.
- 12. No.
- 13. The Requirements for registration are
 - a. The mandatory element is a letter from the owner of original work.
 - b. The is a form which should be filled and submitted to the office of copyright personally, by post, by fax or electronically.
 - c. The registration should be include five copies of the work.
 - d. There is NO fee for registration.
 - e. The time taken to complete the registration depends on the subject of the work and pagination. In general it takes one day or less.
- 14. Only foreigners with legal residence are allowed to register their works.
- 15. Yes, the files are stored in digital forms.
- 16. The registration are classified chronologically.
- 17. Yes, The system have a search facility by name, title, and date of registration.

- 18. No. but the registration is available online.
- 19. No.
- 20. Yes , the public can access to the bibliographic information only but not the contents of the works.
- 21. Yes,
- 22. Yes, there is copyright on the industry practices but through the Ministry of Commerce and Industry.
- 23. Yes.
- 24. No.
- 25. Yes, there is an automated system for registration and recording. But not all information are available to the public.
- 26. The statistical information of copyright registration can be obtained from Ministry of Culture and Information.

B- Legal Deposit:

- 27. Ye, there is a legal deposit legislation system.
- 28. Legal Deposit Law.
- 29. It is mandatory and in the case of non compliance the publisher will be fined with SR 3000 (\$800).
- 30. The main function of the Saudi legal deposit system is preservation of cultural heritage, Collection of statistical information and helping in proofing copyright.
- 31. Yes, there is a connection between copyright law and legal deposit law specially in proofing the copyright.
- 32. No, the copy which is deposited must be the best copy of the work and a photocopy or similar will not be accepted.
- 33. The object of legal deposit is preservation of cultural heritage. The materials to be deposited include printed materials such as books, periodicals, government publications, audio-visual materials, computer programs, art works, and stamps.
- 34. All materials should be assigned Legal deposit number before production / printing and copies should be deposited after printing or production.
- 35. Yes, The top secrete materials are exempted from legal deposit.
- 36. The legal deposit law is applied on the material published in electronic formats. But until now it is not applied to on-line materials.
- 37. TWO copies of the materials should be deposited and ONE copy of thesis and art works.
- 38. The publisher or the producer of the work is responsible for delivering the legal deposit.
- 39. Six menthes after assigning the legal deposit number or the registration will be cancelled.
- 40. No.
- 41. The author, publisher, producer, and distributor are responsible for acting as legal depository.
- 42. No, the public can NOT access to the legal deposited materials, but in case that the material is not available in any place, it can be checked in the site and it is never allowed to check it out.
- 43. Only bibliographic information is available for public.
- 44. Yes, When depository apply for legal deposit number, ISBN, or ISSN will be provided according to Saudi legal deposit law.
