## **BACKGROUND**

Artificial Intelligence (AI) has become a strategic priority for many governments across the globe. In addition, data are a critical component of AI since AI applications rely upon machine learning techniques that use data for training and validation.

As well as Al capacity building, education and regulatory measures, there is a question whether the established intellectual property (IP) system should be modified to in response to Al developments. WIPO has been requested by Member States to provide a forum for discussion of Al and IP Policy, which also includes data. WIPO has therefore started an open conversation on Al/data and IP, including a draft issues paper<sup>I</sup>, and is planning to continue the conversation in Geneva on May 11-12, 2020.

## REQUEST FOR INFORMATION

In order to aid this discussion, WIPO is seeking to collate country/regional information regarding strategies, frameworks and legislation of relevance to Al/data and IP.
