THE HAGUE AGREEMENT CONCERNING THE INTERNATIONAL REGISTRATION OF INDUSTRIAL DESIGNS

Declarations made under Article 7(2) of the 1999 Act and Rule 36(1) of the Common Regulations: Republic of Moldova

1. The Republic of Moldova has made the declaration referred to in Article 7(2) of the 1999 Act and Rule 36(1) of the Common Regulations under the 1999 Act, the 1960 Act and the 1934 Act (which will enter into force on April 1, 2004), whereby the Republic of Moldova wants to receive, instead of the prescribed designation fee, an individual designation fee in connection with any international application in which it is designated, and in connection with the renewal of an international registration designating the Republic of Moldova under the 1999 Act.

2. In accordance with Rule 28(2)(b) of the Common Regulations, the Director General of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) has established, after consultation with the Office of the Republic of Moldova, the following amounts of the said individual fee:

Designation of the Republic of Moldova		Amount (in Swiss francs)
Application	– For one design	65
	– For each additional design in the same application	13
Renewal (under the 1999 Act)	– For one design	65
	– For each additional design in the same registration	13

3. The said declarations will enter into force on April 1, 2004.
