HAGUE AGREEMENT CONCERNING THE INTERNATIONAL REGISTRATION OF INDUSTRIAL DESIGNS

Accession to the 1999 Act: Bosnia and Herzegovina

- 1. On September 24, 2008, the Government of Bosnia and Herzegovina deposited with the Director General of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO), its instrument of accession to the Geneva (1999) Act of the Hague Agreement Concerning the International Registration of Industrial Designs. The 1999 Act will enter into force in respect of Bosnia and Herzegovina on December 24, 2008.
- 2. The accession of Bosnia and Herzegovina to the 1999 Act brings the number of Contracting Parties to this Act to 33 and the total number of Contracting Parties to the Hague Agreement to 54. A list of the Contracting Parties to the Hague Agreement, indicating the date on which Contracting Parties became bound by the 1934 Act, the 1960 Act and/or the 1999 Act, is available on WIPO's website, at the following address: www.wipo.int.
