HAGUE AGREEMENT CONCERNING THE INTERNATIONAL REGISTRATION OF INDUSTRIAL DESIGNS

Level of the Standard Designation Fee Concerning International Applications: Poland

- 1. On July 9, 2009, the Director General of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) received from the Government of Poland, a declaration for the application of level two of the standard designation fee, under Rule 12(1)(c)(i) of the Common Regulations under the 1999 Act, the 1960 Act and the 1934 Act of the Hague Agreement.
- 2. The application of level two of the standard designation fee will take effect on October 9, 2009, with respect to Poland.
- 3. Annexed is a table containing, in respect of each Contracting Party, indications of the Act or Acts binding it and the type of designation fee, if any, payable for the designation of that Contracting Party. This table, which already takes into account the above declaration, will be attached, on October 9, 2009, to form DM/1, which is for applications for international registration governed exclusively or partly by the 1999 Act and/or the 1960 Act, and is available on WIPO's website at http://www.wipo.int/hague/en/forms/.
