

Hague Agreement Concerning the International Registration of Industrial Designs

Accession to the 1999 Act: Brunei Darussalam

1. On September 24, 2013, the Government of Brunei Darussalam deposited with the Director General of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) its instrument of accession to the Geneva (1999) Act of the Hague Agreement Concerning the International Registration of Industrial Designs.
2. The 1999 Act will enter into force, with respect to Brunei Darussalam on December 24, 2013.
3. The accession of Brunei Darussalam to the 1999 Act brings the number of Contracting Parties to this Act to 46. Therefore, the total number of Contracting Parties to the Hague Agreement is 61.
