

Hague Agreement Concerning the International Registration of Industrial Designs

Change in the amounts of the individual designation fee: Japan

1. In accordance with Rule 28(2)(d) of the Common Regulations under the 1999 Act and the 1960 Act of the Hague Agreement, the Director General of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) has established the following new amounts, in Swiss francs, of the individual designation fee which must be paid in connection with an international application in which Japan is designated, and in connection with the renewal of an international registration designating Japan:

Individual Designation Fee		Amounts <i>(in Swiss francs)</i>
International Application	– for each design	603
First Renewal	– for each design	683
Second Renewal	– for each design	683
Third Renewal	– for each design	683
Fourth Renewal	– for each design	683

2. This change will take effect on April 1, 2022.
