## PROTOCOL RELATING TO THE MADRID AGREEMENT CONCERNING THE INTERNATIONAL REGISTRATION OF MARKS

## Accession by the Republic of Zambia

- 1. On August 15, 2001, the Government of the Republic of Zambia deposited with the Director General of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) its instrument of accession to the Protocol Relating to the Madrid Agreement Concerning the International Registration of Marks. The Madrid Protocol will enter into force with respect to the Republic of Zambia on November 15, 2001.
- 2. Accession to the Madrid Protocol by the Republic of Zambia brings the number of Contracting Parties of the Protocol to 54 (namely, Antigua and Barbuda, Armenia, Australia, Austria, Belgium, Bhutan, Bulgaria, China, Cuba, Czech Republic, Democratic People's Republic of Korea, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Georgia, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Japan, Kenya, Latvia, Lesotho, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Monaco, Mongolia, Morocco, Mozambique, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Republic of Moldova, Romania, Russian Federation, Sierra Leone, Singapore, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Swaziland, Sweden, Switzerland, Turkey, Turkmenistan, Ukraine, United Kingdom, Yugoslavia and Zambia) and the membership of the Madrid Union to 70.
- 3.
