MADRID AGREEMENT CONCERNING THE INTERNATIONAL REGISTRATION OF MARKS AND PROTOCOL RELATING THERETO

Declaration Made Under Rule 20 *bis*(6)(b) of the Common Regulations under the Madrid Agreement and Protocol: Russian Federation

1. In a notification addressed to the Director General of the World Intellectual Property Organization, the Russian Federation has made the declaration provided for by Rule 20*bis*(6)(b) of the Common Regulations under the Madrid Agreement, in accordance with which the recording of licences in the International Register has no effect in that country.
2. It follows that a holder or licensee should be aware that, as far as the Russian Federation is concerned, it serves no purpose to request the recording in the International Register of a licence relating to an international registration of mark (such recording carrying no legal effect in that country as a result of the said declaration). Consequently, the formalities required for the recording in the Russian Federation of a licence relating to an international registration of mark must continue to be completed directly with the Office of the Russian Federation and according to the conditions laid down by the legislation of that country.
3. This declaration entered into force on April 1, 2002.
