MADRID PROTOCOL CONCERNING THE INTERNATIONAL REGISTRATION OF MARKS

Accession to the Madrid Protocol: Kyrgyzstan

- 1. On March 17, 2004, the Government of Kyrgyzstan deposited with the Director General of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) its instrument of accession to the Madrid Protocol Concerning the International Registration of Marks.
- 2. The said instrument of accession was accompanied by the declaration referred to in Article 8(7) of the Protocol, whereby Kyrgyzstan wants to receive an individual fee when it is designated under the Protocol in an international application, in a subsequent designation or in respect of the renewal of an international registration designating Kyrgyzstan under the Protocol (instead of a share in the revenue produced by the supplementary and complementary fees). The amounts in Swiss francs of the said individual fee are the following:

Designation fee (in the international application or in a subsequent designation):	CHF
 for one class of goods or services for each additional class 	340 160
Renewal fee:	СНБ
 irrespective of the number of classes 	500

- 3. The Madrid Protocol, including the declaration for individual fee made under Article 8(7), will enter into force with respect to Kyrgyzstan on June 17, 2004.
- 4. Accession to the Madrid Protocol by Kyrgyzstan brings the number of Contracting Parties of the said Protocol to 63. A list of the members of the Madrid Union, indicating the date on which Contracting Parties became bound by the Madrid Agreement and/or the Protocol, is available under the heading "List of Members" on the International Marks page on WIPO's website, at the following address: *www.wipo.int*.
