

Show and Tell Presentation Competition

List of common questions and answers

Q. Can I apply if I am not a Japanese national?

A. Anyone who has student status in Japan can apply.

Q. Can parents help their children to complete online registration?

A. Yes, parents can support their children to complete online registration as long as it is the applicant child who is making the presentation. Please be informed that the parental consent is required for under-aged participants.

Q. Is application only available in Japanese?

A. No. You can submit your presentation either in Japanese or English.

Q. What kind of prize will be awarded?

A. Two expected awards (Gold and Silver) will be given to two winners from each education level (i.e. primary, secondary and high school as well as university). They will each receive a certificate of commendation and Amazon gift cards as a prize. Please note that the amount of the gift cards will vary depending on the awards and education levels.

Q. I have not turned my idea into material invention, but can I still present about it?

A. Yes, it is also very welcome to present your ideas or even intangible things. For instance, you can present about SDGs-related topics, or interview that reflects your opinions.

Q. How will submitted video be treated after application?

A. Only those shortlisted will be used for IP awareness raising purposes on WIPO platforms.

Q. Is it possible to register for the presentation competition as an observer?

A. Only the finalists and one parent/guardian are invited to the presentation competition which will be held in person at the United Nations University, However, the event will also be streamed online. Please register in advance to watch the live event..

Additionally, digest videos of the event and awarded presentations will be available on the WIPO webpage at a later date.

Q. Can I submit the video that has been published online such as on my social media?

A. No you cannot submit a video that has been previously published. For further details, please refer to [competition rule 5.2.3](#).

Q. Are there any requirements on aspect ratio or quality of the video?

A. No, there are no such requirements, however, the size of video needs to be up to 100MB for submission.
