# CURRENT ACCOUNT AT WIPO: DEPOSIT YOUR FUNDS

Hey there! Welcome to our tutorial.

In this video you will learn how to deposit funds into your Current Account at WIPO.

Please note that you can deposit funds to your Current Account at WIPO **in Swiss Francs only**.

If you do money transfers in another currency, the amount will be converted to Swiss Francs at the bank's exchange rate.

You can use bank or postal transfer to replenish your Current Account.

To find the bank and postal transfer payment details, go to WIPO's official website and click on "Protect and Manage".
