**National disclaimers**

According to Art. 4, para. 3, item 1 of the Tariff for fees, which are collected by the Patent Office of the Republic of Bulgaria for filing an application for international registration, fees in the amount of BGN 150 to three classes shall be collected, for each following class an additional fee of BGN 50.

Upon payment of fees, the incoming or registered number of the basic mark, data for the mark, data for the applicant or the industrial property representative and the points of the Tariff for fees for which the payment has been made shall be entered in the payment document.

It is not allowed to transfer a paid fee for one application to another application.

If the fees are not paid or the amount is insufficient, the application for international registration will not be forwarded to WIPO.

The international application must be in English or French.

Where the applicant is a legal entity, the transliteration may be replaced by a translation into the language of the application.

If the requirements concerning language are not complied with, an international application will not be co-processed and will be returned to the sender.




