HAGUE AGREEMENT CONCERNING THE INTERNATIONAL REGISTRATION OF INDUSTRIAL DESIGNS

Information concerning the requirement under national legislation for the inclusion of a short description of the characteristic features of the design in an application for registration: Serbia

- 1. By a communication dated March 4, 2009, relating to Article 8(4) of the 1960 Act of the Hague Agreement, the Intellectual Property Office of Serbia informed the International Bureau of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) that, pursuant to the Serbian Law on the Legal Protection of Design, an application for registration must contain a short description of the characteristic features of the design.
- 2. Users of the Hague system are therefore encouraged to supply a short description of the characteristic features of the design whenever Serbia is designated in an international application. Such description shall comply with the requirements of Rule 11(2) of the Common Regulations under the 1999 Act, the 1960 Act and the 1934 Act of the Hague Agreement.
