- b. Started 2006.
- c. Full-time: 1.5 to 2 years or Part-time: 2 to 4 years.
- d. Part 1: GCIP.
- e. Part 2: IP Management and Management of Technology components taught by lecturers from the Division

of Engineering and Technology Management, Faculty of Engineering, NUS.

- f. Degree conferred by NUS (Faculty of Engineering).

## Challenges:

- a. Curriculum for GCIP developed by the Faculty of Law and for M Sc. by the Faculty of engineering.
- b. Inputs from IP Academy are considered but not necessarily adopted.
- c. Fee differences between certificate and Masters not significant.
- d. Student enrollment sufficient as long as GCIP is required for registered patent agent requirements.
- e. Lecturers are subjected to approval by the respective Faculty.
