Inception of idea to commercialization



#### **IP** BENEFITS

- Society-
  - Meet demands and needs
  - Address scientific & technological challenges
  - Stimulate inventive & innovative activities & commercialization
  - Facilitates the dissemination and use of new technical knowledge
  - Promotes fair competition & trade

### **IP** COSTS & RISKS

- Protection & enforcement
  - Protection without registration/ No costtrade secret and copyright but ??
  - Cost of Registration-Patent, Designs, Marks etc.
    - Professional service fee

Official and administrative fees

## **IP** COSTS & RISKS

Cost of enforcement

- Cost involved in monitoring infringement
- Cost in taking enforcement action
- Uncertainty of title & potential to be challenged- cost of defending title

### **IP COSTS TO SOCIETY**

- Administering IP
- Restriction or limit access to & use of IP assets
- Impacts on reverse engineering and imitation
- Increased widening of the scope of protection
- Potential abuse of monopoly rights

### **COST- BENEFIT TRADEOFF**

- Patentability requirement
- Disclosure requirement
- Limitations and exceptions
- Duration of protection
- Safeguards and sanctions
