

PARTS OF PATENT APPLICATION

- Title of the invention
 - Abstract
 - Field of invention
 - Background of invention
 - Summary
 - Detailed descriptions and drawings
 - Claims



- Provides a summary of the invention
- Primarily an aid for patent searches
- Normally receives very little substantive review

RETAILER RESCRIPTION OF INVENTION

- Enables the claims by providing sufficient technical disclosure of the invention
- Step wise description of the invention
- Product
 - Formulation



Provides the boundaries for protection

- Defines the scope of exclusive protection
- What is it that is your own idea?
- Broad claims
- Main claims
- Consisting and comprising

EXAMPLES OF CLAIMS

- A patent applicant has invented a rice cooker.
 - Since an object of this invention is to cook rice, the preamble and title might read as follows:
 - Preamble
 - An apparatus for cooking rice,
 - An apparatus for cooking grains
 - An apparatus for cooking
