## INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION TO PROMOTE IP SYSTEM DEVELOPMENT

- Strengthen existing bilateral and multilateral relations with intellectual property offices in other countries and further institutionalize his relations through regular monitoring of cooperation programs.
- Establish new cooperative relationships with intellectual property offices in emerging and developed countries to seek out proven experiences and best practices and increase the exchange of strategic information.
- To put in place effective cooperation actions to exchange experiences and pool resources.

## Main cooperation activities

- Exchange of strategic information, documentation, data and experience and worksharing with international partners
- Dissemination of technical information and promotion of innovation (in both national and regional levels)
- Capacity building and trainings (for employees and national operators)
- Promotion of IP to users of partner countries
- Protection of industrial property (such as Patent Prosecution Highway, validation system,...)
- Anti-counterfeiting actions
- Transfer of know-how and best practices through study visits, training programs, conferences and workshops
- Promotion of IP to users via compaigns and events organized in partnership with WIPO, OAPI, EPO,... (in Morocco and other African Coutries)
- Promotion of innovation among researchers and inventors (universities and research centers) in African countries
- South-South Cooperation
