COMMON IP ISSUES-SOUTH ASIA

- Minimal public awareness about IP
- Lack of knowledge among the enforcement agencies
- Lack of legislation in some countries i.e. Maldives and antiquated laws in others, i.e. Bangladesh
- High rate of counterfeit goods and piracy
- Lack of effective deterrents
- Lack of experts with comprehensive knowledge about IP issues
- Digitization in IP offices-not prevalent yet
- Backlog in prosecution of applications
- Other crimes/issues considered bigger than IP
