





## ASEAN: IP Eco System

#### ASEAN ECONOMIC COMMUNITY BLUEPRINT, 2025


- Strengthening IP Offices and build IP infrastructure:
  - Accession to International Treaties: Patent Cooperation Treaty (PCT), Madrid Protocol, Hague Agreement and Singapore Treaty on the Law of Trademarks (STLT)
  - Launch of ASEAN Designview (August 25, 2015)
- More than 100,000 design registrations having effects in the participating ASEAN countries (Brunei Darussalam, Cambodia, Lao PDR, Malaysia, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand and Viet Nam)
  - Indonesia and Myanmar expected to join soon



## Viet Nam: Legal Framework

- IP Law (adopted in 2005 and amended in 2009);
- Decree No 103/2006/ND-CP dated 22 September 2006 of the Government on detail regulations concerning industrial property;
- Circular No 01/2007/TT-BKHCN dated 14 February 2007 of Ministry of Science and Technology on guidance of the procedures for IP right establishment to industrial property objects (amended in 2010 and 2011);
- The Guidelines dated of 8 December 2009 of the NOIP on examination of design applications.



## Steps for accession...

Implementation and Operating the Hague System

- Regulations concerning internal procedures as the Office of a Designated Contracting Party (and as the Office of Indirect Filing);
- The Office shall be technically ready to support the said procedures;
- Form of communication with the International Bureau shall be agreed before accession.

## Consultation with Stakeholders; Raising Public Awareness

- Legislative Procedure to Accede to the 1999 Act
  - Possible amendments to the national design law
  - Enforcement of IP rights

## Instrument of Accession; Declarations under the 1999 Act

- The 1999 Act comes into force in respect of Viet Nam three months after the deposit of its instrument of accession with the Director General of WIPO, or at any later date as indicated in the instrument of accession
- Contracting Parties may make certain declarations in order to comply with their national laws concerning industrial design protection
  - Declarations may be made either simultaneously with the deposit of the instrument of accession, or after the deposit (for example, following amendments to the national law)

## Accession of Viet Nam to the 1999 Act

Article 6.1 of Law on Signing, Joining and Implementing International Treaties:

«In cases where a legal document and a treaty to which the Socialist Republic of Vietnam is a party, contains different provisions on the same matter, the provisions of the treaty shall prevail.»

- Amendments to the national law to be made after the accession to the 1999 Act of the Hague Agreement
- Implementing Regulations to be amended to refer to international procedures

## Foreseen Declarations by Viet Nam


- Mandatory declaration
  - Maximum duration of protection (Article 17(3)(c))
- Other possible declarations (to be confirmed)
  - Designation fees (Article 7(2) or Rule 12(1))
  - No deferment of publication (Article 11(1)(b))
  - Unity of design (Article 13(1))



## Viet Nam: Applications / Registrations at NOIP and Abroad







4,111 international applications were received containing 16,435 designs (max. 100 designs / application)

3,581 international registrations were inscribed containing 14,484 designs




32.48% growth compared to 2014 in the number of registrations



7.25% growth compared to 2014 in the number of designs


# Most designated Contracting Parties in 2015 (number of designs recorded)






#### **Origins of Holders of Designs in International Registrations: 2015**




## **Designs in International Registrations 2010-2015**




## **Designs per International Registration (2015)**

(Coming soon) E-Loop Project: Reply to irregularities online

Precondition: user/applicant has WIPO User account

- Applicant may reply to an irregularity raised by the examiner concerning his international application
- Applicant may submit documents, such as a copy of the power of attorney or image files, with his reply
- Applicant may consult current status of his international application in real time

## Legal Development of the Hague System

- The sixth session of the Working Group on the Legal Development of the Hague System will take place from June 20 to 22, 2016
  - Since its second session in 2012, the Delegation of Viet Nam has activily participated in the Working Group
  - The Hague Union Assembly will take place in October 2016
    - A proposal for amendments to Rule 5 of the Common Regulations (failure to meet a time limit for electronic communications addressed to the International Bureau) will be submitted to the Assembly, for adoption
    - Other possible proposals to be discussed in the sixth session of the Working Group, in June 2016
