Legal Preparations:

- 1. Study of Madrid Protocol
- 2. Accession
 - Executive Track
 - · Endorsement of the DTI, DFA and Solicitor General
 - . Signature of the President

OR

- Legislative Track
 - · Senate Ratification



Technical Preparations

- Updating of Database
- Upgrading of Infrastructure
- Business Process Re-engineering
- Review of Trademark Law and Rules
- Revisit Functional Groupings of the Bureau of Trademarks



Advocacy

- Basic Orientation Seminars
- Endorsement of Key Stakeholders
- → Phil. Chamber of Commerce and Industry (PCCI and other Business Groups)



Challenges

- Lukewarm Response of some IP Practitioners
- Readiness in terms of manpower and skills to meet the influx of applications
- Capacity of local and rural SMEs to use Madrid
