

## ANNEX I

## TREATMENT OF SEPARATE INDEXING SCHEMES IN THE IPC

The ad hoc IPC Reform Working Group made decisions on whether to abolish or to retain an indexing scheme taking into account, in particular, the statistics of the use of indexing schemes. In some cases, it also recommended additional actions such as conversion to a classification scheme. It should be recalled that all indexing schemes, to be abolished or to be retained, should be considered from the viewpoint as to whether it would be appropriate to convert them to classification schemes (see Guidelines for the Conversion of Existing IPC Indexing Schemes into Classification Schemes).

The following table shows all separate indexing schemes in the IPC, decisions made by the ad hoc IPC Reform Working Group, offices-rapporteurs responsible for the preparation of the proposals relating to each indexing scheme and decisions made by the IPC Revision Working Group.

## TREATMENT OF DOUBLE-PURPOSE SCHEMES
