Article12

Transfer

Contracting Parties may provide that exclusive rights of authorization provided for in this Agreement are transferred, with respect to a particular audiovisual fixation, from the performer to the producer of that particular fixation.

${\bf Agreed statement concerning the law applicable to a transfer by a greement}$

Withoutprejudicetointernationalobligations, the understanding is here by confirmed that a transfer by agreement of exclusive rights of authorization granted under this Agreement shall be governed by the law of the country chosen by the parties or, to the extent that the law applicable to the contract has not been chosen, by the law of the country most closely connected with it, without prejudice to any mandatory rules, including on in alien ability and unwaivability of rights, in the law of the country where protection is sought.
