#### Article19

### ApplicationinTime

(1) ContractingPartiesshallapplytheprovisionsofArticle18ofthe BerneConvention, *mutatis mutandis*, totherightsofperformersprovidedforinthisAgreement.

(2) Notwithstandingparagraph(1),aContractingPartymayl imittheapplication of Article5ofthisAgreementtoperformanceswhichoccurredaftertheentryintoforceofthis AgreementforthatParty.

### AgreedstatementconcerningArticle19

Forthepurposes of this Agreement, it is here by confirmed that Artic le 18 of the Berne Convention is without prejudice to any acts concluded and rights acquired in any Contracting State before the date of coming into force of the Convention for that State, and that Article 18 of the Berne Conventional lows Contracting States to establish transitional provisions under which any person who engaged in law ful acts with respect to a work, prior to the entry into force of the Convention for the respective State, may under take with respect to the same work acts with in the scope of the rights provided for in the Convention after the entry into force of the Convention for the respective Contracting State.
