Article4

NationalTreatment

- $(1) \quad Each Contracting Party shall accord to nationals \quad of other Contracting Parties the treatment that it accords to its own nationals with regard to the exclusive rights specifically granted in this agreement and the right to equitable remuneration provided for in Article 11 of this agreement.$
- $(2) A Contra\ cting Partyshall be entitled to limit the extent and term of the protection accorded to nationals of another Contracting Party under paragraph (1), with respect to the rights granted in Article 11 (1) and 11 (2) of this agreement, to those rights that its own nationals enjoy in that other Contracting Party.$
- (3) The obligation provided for in paragraph (1) does not apply to a Contracting Party that makes use of the reservations permitted by Article 11 (3) of this agreement.
