Thereport of the seventh session of the Standing Committee on Copyright and Related Rights (SCCR) is here by revised with the insertion of two words "difference between" in line 8 of paragraph 31. For ease of reference, ther evised paragraph 31 is reproduced below.

"31. TheDelegationofAustraliafoundthetechnicalbackgroundpaperofenormoushelp. Therewascertaincommongroundwhendiscussingtraditionalbroadcastingovertheair, cabletransmissionsandtransmissions throughInternet.Inthatrespect, however, it asked for clarification of the same issues that we reraised by the Delegation of Singapore. Further guidance was needed with reference to the essential difference between transmissions madepointtopoint,s uchasstreamingontheInternettransmissionsinrealtime,andpointto multipoint, as in the case of broadcasting over the air. If a certain minimum of interactivity was being discussed, the Delegation asked what was the difference between real time Internet transmission and cable delivery, since the latter also required some interactive steps. TheDelegation queried the distinction between the broadcast signal and its content. It must be cleartoallthatthereferencetosignalswastoprogram -carryingsignals, whether sounds or sounds and images. Finally, its hared the viewex pressed by the Delegation of the European Community that the fundamental rational effort protection was the investment which had to be a subscription of the subscriptmadetoproduceandtransmittheprogram -carryingsignals."
