ELECTRONICEXCHANGEOFINFORMATION: ESTABLISHMENTOFA NELECTRONICFORUM

1. Duringthefirstsessionofthe *AdvisoryCommitteeonEnforcementofIndustrial PropertyRights(ACE/IP)* heldinGenevaonOctober19and20,2000,theACE/IPagreed thatanElectroni cForumbeestablished,inlinewiththeforaestablishedundertheStanding CommitteeontheLawofTrademarks(SCT)andtheStandingCommitteeontheLawof Patents(SCP).¹

2. TheJointMeetingof *theAdvisoryCommitteeonEnforcementofIndustrialProperty Rights*(SecondSession)andofthe *AdvisoryCommitteeonManagementandEnforcementof CopyrightandRelatedRightsinGlobalInformationNetworks* (ThirdSession)(hereinafter referredtoasACE/IP -ACMEC),heldinGenevafromDecember 18 to 20, 2001,was concludedwithaSummarybytheChair ².Inparagraph 1(a)oftheSummarybytheChair, adoptedbytheAdvisoryCommittees,itwasstatedthat"[T]heInternationalBureauisinvited toestablishanElectronicForuminsuchawayastofacilit atetheexchangeofinformation relatingtoenforcementissues,ascalledforbyvariousdelegationsinthecourseoftheJoint MeetingoftheAdvisoryCommittees..."

3. Followingtheabove, and in accordance with Sub -program10.4"IntellectualPoperty EnforcementIssuesandStrategies" of the Program and Budgetfor the 2002-2003biennium,anElectronicForumonIntellectualPropertyEnforcementIssuesand Strategies(hereinreferredtoas"theElectronicForum")isproposedtobeestablished.T he ElectronicForumwouldbeopenforparticipationbyallMemberStatesandObservers -ACMEC³, which will be subsequently indicated in the list of contact points to the ACE/IP extended on the basis of additional information from governments and interestedgovernmentalandnon -governmentalorganizations.TheInternationalBureauwouldprovide administrative support for the maintenance of the Electronic Forum. An alternative means ofparticipation for those who wish to participate in the Electronic Forum, b utdonothaveaccess toe -mail,wouldbeviafacsimiletransmissionorexpressmail.

4. TheElectronicForumwouldbeusedtomakeworkingdocumentsavailableonaspecial sectionoftheWIPOwebsite(notadvertisedtothegeneralpublic)andp rovideforthe electronicreceiptofcommentsthereto.Thiswouldenhancethequalityoftheworking documents, and will permit discussions at future meetings on enforcement to focus on substantive issues.

5. Inaddition, the Electronic Forum would be used to facilitate the collection of information related to work under taken by WIPO by providing for the electronic distribution of requests for information and responses thereto. It would also provide an electronic means where by participants can request to share information as to their respective national experiences in the field of enforcement.

GeneralProce dures

 $The Electronic Forum on Intellectual Property Enforcement Is sues and Strategies (here in referred to as "the Electronic Forum") will be launched in October 2002. \label{eq:20}$

The following general procedures will be followed both for the presentation of commt sin relation to documents made available by the International Bureau and, where applicable, for the collection of information related to work under taken by WIPO:

(a) UponcompletionandtranslationofadraftworkingdocumentbytheInternational Bureau,thedocumentwillbepostedinthreelanguages(English,FrenchandSpanish), utilizingtwotechnicalformatsforeachlanguage(AdobePDFandMS -Word),onthe Internet,onahiddenpage(notadvertisedtothegeneralpublic)oftheWIPOwebsite.

(b) Atthesametime,acommunicationwillbesentbytheInternationalBureauto eachoftheparticipantsintheElectronicForum,indicatingthetitleandprovisionalnumberof thedocument,theInternetlocations(URLs)ofthedifferentversionsofthedo cument,andthe periodforreceiptofcomments.Thecommunicationwillbesenttoeachparticipantviathe meansindicatedintheRegistrationFormforreceiptofcommunications(e -mail;ife -mailis notavailable,facsimile;ife -mailandfacsimileare notavailable,post).

(c) CorrespondentswhoindicatedintheirRegistrationFormthatInternetaccesswas availablewillsimplyaccessthedocumentontheInternet.Correspondentswhoindicatedthat Internetaccesswasnotavailablewillreceivethed ocument,inthelanguageindicatedinthe RegistrationForm,viathemeansindicatedforreceiptofdocuments(e -mail;ife -mailisnot available,post.Fordocumentslessthan10pageslong,facsimilemaybeused,where available).

(d) Comments, and r esponsesto comments, concerning the draft document may be submitted to the International Bureauin English, Frenchor Spanish viae -mail, orinany of the six official languages of WIPO by facsimile or by post. A special, easy -to-usee -mail response form , including a facility for sending attachments, will be available on the Forum website. Comments, whether submitted by -mail, facsimile or post, will be posted for viewing on the Forum website at the discretion of the International Bureau.

(e) Comments, and responses to comments, which are received prior to the expiration of the comment period will be incorporated by the International Bureau, as appropriate, into a finalized version of the document. Comments, and responses to comments, which are received after the expiration of the comment period may be taken into account by the International Bureau, depending on the circumstances and time of receipt.

(i) Theseprocedures will be reviewed at future meetings, on the basis of experience, and in light of particular needs and developments in the fiel do fen forcement.
