Introduction

WIPO

1. The membership of the WIPO Coordination Committee consists of States drawn from three other bodies, namely

- (i) the Executive Committee of the Paris Union;
- (ii) the Executive Committee of the Berne Union; and

(iii) one-fourth of the States party to the Convention Establishing the World Intellectual Property Organization ("the WIPO Convention") that are not members of any of the Unions administered by WIPO.¹

In addition, Switzerland, as the host State, is an *ex officio* member of the Coordination Committee.²

2. The membership of the Coordination Committee is established once every two years, at the ordinary sessions of the Assemblies of the Member States ("the Assemblies"). The terms of office of the present members of the Executive Committee of the Paris Union, the Executive Committee of the Berne Union and the WIPO Coordination Committee expire at the close of the present (September 22 to October 1, 2009) ordinary sessions of the Assemblies. New members of each of those Committees must therefore be elected during the present sessions of the Assemblies. Those new members will serve until the close of the next ordinary sessions of the Assemblies, which will be held in September 2011.

3. The present document deals with the composition of the Committees that are to be elected and the decisions that the corresponding Assemblies and other bodies are invited to take in order to elect the new members of the Committees.

I. <u>Executive Committee of the Paris Union</u>

4. <u>Present Composition</u>. The Executive Committee of the Paris Union comprises, at present, 42 members, consisting of 41 ordinary members,³ and one *ex officio* member.⁴ The names of the present members are underlined in List No. 1 in the Annex to this document.

5. <u>Limits to Re-eligibility for Election</u>. Members of the Executive Committee of the Paris Union may be re-elected, but only up to a maximum of two-thirds of the ordinary members plus the *ex officio* member.⁵ There being 42 such members, the number of elected ordinary members eligible for re-election is 28.⁶

6. <u>New Composition</u>. The Executive Committee of the Paris Union to serve from the close of the present sessions of the Assemblies to the close of the next ordinary sessions of the Assemblies should have 42^7 members, consisting of:

(i) 41 elected ordinary members, to be elected by the Assembly of the Paris Union; out of the present 41 elected members, 27 may and 14 may not be re-elected;

(ii) one *ex officio* member (Switzerland).

> 7. Accordingly, the Assembly of the Paris Union is invited to elect, from among its members, 41 States to the Executive Committee of the Paris Union, in the capacity of ordinary members; these 41 States must not include more than 27 States which, at present, are ordinary members of that Committee.

II. <u>Executive Committee of the Berne Union</u>

8. <u>Present Composition</u>. The Executive Committee of the Berne Union comprises, at present, 40 members, consisting of 39 ordinary members⁸ and one *ex officio* member.⁹ The names of the present members are underlined in List No. 2 in the Annex to this document.

9. <u>Limits to Re-eligibility for Election</u>. Members of the Executive Committee of the Berne Union may be re-elected, but only up to a maximum of two-thirds of the ordinary members plus the *ex officio* member.¹⁰ There being 40 such members, the number of elected ordinary members eligible for re-election is 27.¹¹

10. <u>New Composition</u>. The Executive Committee of the Berne Union to serve from the close of the present sessions of the Assemblies to the close of the next ordinary sessions of the Assemblies should have 40^{12} members, consisting of:

(i) 39 elected ordinary members, to be elected by the Assembly of the Berne Union; out of the present 39 elected members, 26 may and 13 may not be re-elected;

(ii) one *ex officio* member (Switzerland).

11. Accordingly, the Assembly of the Berne Union is invited to elect, from among its members, 39 States to the Executive Committee of the Berne Union; these 39 States must not include more than 26 States which, at present, are members of that Committee.

III. <u>WIPO Coordination Committee</u>

12. <u>Rules of Composition</u>. The WIPO Coordination Committee is composed of the following categories of members:

(i) the elected ordinary members of the Executive Committee of the Paris Union and of the Executive Committee of the Berne Union;¹³

(ii) Switzerland, as the State on whose territory the Organization has its headquarters;¹⁴

(iii) one-fourth of the States party to the WIPO Convention that are not members of any of the Unions, which are designated by the WIPO Conference¹⁵ and which serve as *ad hoc* members of the WIPO Coordination Committee.¹⁶

13. The names of the present *ad hoc* members are underlined in List No. 3 in the Annex to this document.

14. <u>New Composition</u>. It follows that the WIPO Coordination Committee to serve from the close of the present sessions of the Assemblies to the close of the next ordinary sessions of the Assemblies should have 83 members, consisting of:

(i) the 41 ordinary members of the Executive Committee of the Paris Union to be elected by the Assembly of the Paris Union in the present sessions (see paragraph 6(i), above);

(ii) the 39 ordinary members of the Executive Committee of the Berne Union to be elected by the Assembly of the Berne Union in the present sessions (see paragraph 10(i), above);

(iii) Switzerland; and

(iv) two *ad hoc* members to be designated by the WIPO Conference in the present sessions. 17
