ARTICLE 7 BIS

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEES OF THE
UNIONS

(1) The General Assembly of each Union shall elect, from among the Member States of the Union, an Executive Committee.

(2) The number of the States Members of the Executive Committee shall correspond to one-fourth of the States Members of the Union. In establishing the number of seats to be filled remainders after division by four shall be disregarded.

(3) (Equitable distribution along the same principles as in Article 7(2g)).

(4) (Renewal of at least one third according to the principles of Article 7(2b)).

(5) (Powers corresponding to those of the Executive Board but, of course, exercised vis-à-vis the General Assembly of the Union, according to the principles of Article 7 (3) except (iv)).

(6) (Provisions corresponding to Article 7 (4) to (7)).

ARTICLE 7 TER

COORDINATION COMMITTEE

(1) The Coordination Committee shall comprise the States Members of the Executive Board of the Organization, the Executive Committee of the Paris Union, and the Executive Committee of the Berne Union.

(2) If the other Unions administered by the Organization wish to be represented as such in the Coordination Committee, their representatives must be appointed from amongst the representatives of States Members of the Coordination Committee.

(3) Each State Member of the Coordination Committee shall have one vote. It may be represented by one or two Delegates who may be accompanied at sessions of the Coordination Committee by advisers.

(4) Any State Member of the Organization, which is not a Member of the Coordination Committee, may be represented at debates of the Committee by observers. The observers of such a State have the right to take part in the debates; they do not have the right to vote.

(5) The nature of the functions of the Coordination Committee is purely consultative. In particular, it shall give advice to the other organs of the Organization and the Unions on administrative, financial and other matters of common interest to the Organization and the Unions or certain of them.

[The other details shall also follow the Rules of Procedure of the Interunion Coordination Committee.]

ARTICLE 9

FINANCES

(1) The budget of the Organization consists of the separate budgets of the Unions and the general budget of the Organization.

(2) The separate budgets of the Unions are adopted by the General Assemblies of the various Unions.

(3) The separate budgets of the Paris, Berne, Nice Unions, and the general budget of the Organization, shall be financed from contributions by Member States.

(4) For the purpose of establishing the contribution of each Member State in the various budgets, it shall belong to a class and shall pay its annual contribution on the basis of a fixed number of units as follows:

Class I	25
Class II	20
Class III	15
Class IV	10
Class V	5
Class VI	3
