PROPOSAL PRESENTED BY Mr. PUGET (FRANCE) IN HIS PERSONAL CAPACITY

Article 1

The Community (or General Union) for the Protection of Intellectual Property (CPIP) or (GUPIP), resulting from the Present Administrative Convention, groups, while fully respecting their autonomy, the Unions and Agreements relating to intellectual property. It comprises for the administration of matters of common interest to these Unions and Agreements a General Secretariat which replaces BIRPI, a General Assembly of the Unions assisted by a Coordination Committee, and a consultative Conference.

This Article would be followed by the present Article 3 and the present Articles concerning the Unions, their organs, the General Secretariat, the General (or Plenary) Assembly, and the Conference.
