CONFIRMATION OF ICIREPAT

Report by the Director of BIRPI

SUMMARY

This document contains the suggestion that the Assembly and the Conference of Representatives of the Paris Union confirm ICIREPAT.

1. The Conference of Representatives of the Paris Union, in its second ordinary session held in December 1967, decided to transform the "Committee for International Cooperation in Information Retrieval Among Examining Patent Offices (ICIREPAT)" into a committee of experts of the Paris Union and gave it the name of "Paris Union Committee for International Cooperation in Information Retrieval Among Patent Offices (ICIREPAT)."

2. In view of the administrative reorganization of the Paris Union under the Stockholm Act of the Paris Convention, it would seem appropriate that the Assembly and the (new) Conference of Representatives of the Paris Union should decide that ICIREPAT be maintained as a committee of experts of the Paris Union.

3. The Assembly and the Conference of Representatives of the Paris Union are invited to confirm ICIREPAT.

SUMMARY

This document contains the suggestions that the Assembly and the Conference of Representatives of the Paris Union should consider.

1. The Conference of Representatives of the Paris Union in its second ordinary session held in Geneva, 1950, decided to transfer the Committee for International Cooperation in Intellectual Property Administration among Parisian States to the Paris Union and give it the name of "Paris Union Committee for International Cooperation in Intellectual Property Administration".

2. In view of the administrative responsibilities of the Paris Union under the provisions of the Paris Convention, it would seem appropriate that the Assembly and the Conference of Representatives of the Paris Union should decide that ICIPIAT be maintained as a committee of experts of the Paris Union.

The Assembly and the Conference of Representatives of the Paris Union are invited to consider ICIPIAT.
