Report by the Director of BIRPI

Supplement to document CCIU/VII/6

- Reference is made to document CCIU/VII/6, paragraphs 26 to 28, in which it was stated that the Geneva Authorities had indicated their readiness to rent the "Horngacher" plot to BIRPI but that the negotiations had not yet been concluded at the time of writing the said document.
- Since that time, negotiations have continued and the outcome is reflected in a letter, dated September 12, 1969, which was addressed to the Director of BIRPI by the Councillor of State in charge of the Department of Public Works of the Republic and Canton of Geneva.
- That letter informed the Director of BIRPI that the State of Geneva was ready to make the "Horngacher" plot available to BIRPI on a rental basis the terms and conditions of which were still to be discussed, and that a final decision could be made by the Council of State only when those terms and conditions had been settled. The letter at the same time expressed the opinion that there was therefore nothing to prevent BIRPI from going ahead with its proposals to hold a competition on a limited scale inviting the submission of plans in connection with the construction of the new building.
