PHONOGRAMS CONVENTION

- 1. Since April 1, 2005, the date given in document ILO/UNESCO/WIPO/ICR.19/4. submitted in June 2005 to the nineteenth ordinary session of the Intergovernmental Committee, the Phonograms Convention has entered into force for Liberia on December 16, 2005; Vietnam on July 6, 2005; and Montenegro on June 3, 2006, by virtue of its article 11, paragraph 2, the governments of those countries having deposited their instruments of accession or ratification with the Secretary-General of the United Nations.
- 2. Therefore, on October 15, 2008, the following 76 States were party to the Phonograms Convention.

4. Since 1 April 2005, the date given in document ILO/UNESCO/WIPO/ICR.19/4. submitted in June 2005 to the nineteenth ordinary session of the Intergovernmental Committee, the Satellites Convention has entered into force for Singapore on April 27, 2005; Montenegro on June 3, 2006; Vietnam on January 12, 2006; Bahrain on May 1, 2007; Honduras on April 7, 2008; Oman on March 18, 2008; and the Republic of Moldova on October 28, 2008 by virtue of its article 11, paragraph 2, the governments of those countries having deposited their instruments of accession with the Secretary-General of the United Nations.
