## Opening of the Session

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- 1. The Assembly of the Nice Union (hereinafter called "the Assembly") held its first ordinary session at Geneva from September 21 to 28, 1970.
- 2. The following States, members of the Assembly at the opening of the session, were represented: Belgium, Czechoslovakia, Denmark, France, Germany (Federal Republic), Hungary, Italy, Ireland, Israel, Morocco, Netherlands, Norway, Portugal, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, United Kingdom, Yugoslavia (18).
- 3. The States and organizations which were represented by observers are shown in the list of participants (document AB/I/INF/2.Rev.).
- 4. The session was opened by Mr. Edward Armitage (United Kingdom), Chairman of the Ad Hoc Committee of the Whole (see document AB/I/32, paragraph 5), acting as provisional Chairman of the Assembly.

5. The agenda was adopted as proposed in document N/A/I/1.Rev. and was later completed by a new item, "Headquarters Building."
