







Figure A.1.1 Trend in international applications (2001-2017)



Top Five Classes (2017)






Top Ten Filing Origins (2017)


Number of Madrid applications and % growth since 2016



Top Ten Applicants (2017)




Top Ten Designated Contracting Parties (2017)
