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



### Remarks

#### EM

The designation of the European Union covers its Member States (Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Ireland, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, The Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden) and, during a transition period, the United Kingdom.

By designating the EUIPO, the applicant can claim the seniority of an earlier mark registered in, or for, a Member State of the European Community.

#### JP

Japan's individual fees are payable in two parts. The first part of the individual fee is paid at the time of filing. The second part is paid only if Japan is satisfied that the mark of international registration qualifies for protection. The date and the amount due of the second part fees will be notified to the holder at a later stage.

#### SG

By designating Singapore, the applicant declares that he has the intention that the mark will be used by him or with his consent in that country in connection with the aforementioned goods and services.

#### US

By designating the United States of America, it is compulsory to complete the Declaration of Intention to use (MM18) screen. Note: in the United States one must confirm a trademark after five years. [Learn more](#)
