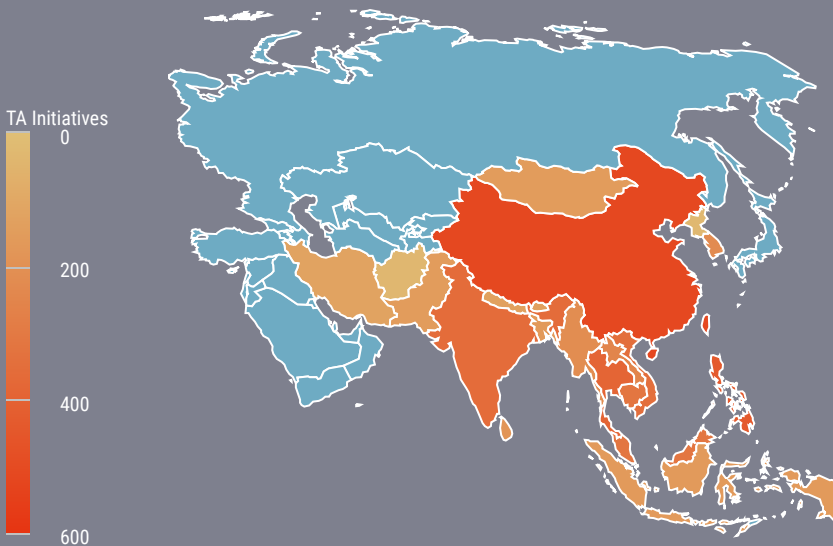

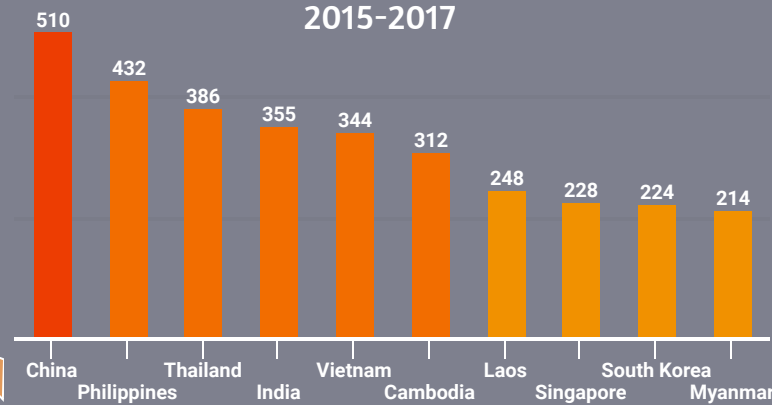

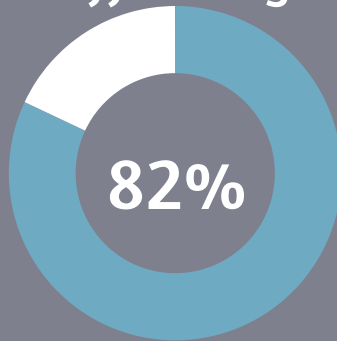
## WIPO Technical Assistance - Top 10 countries 2015-2017



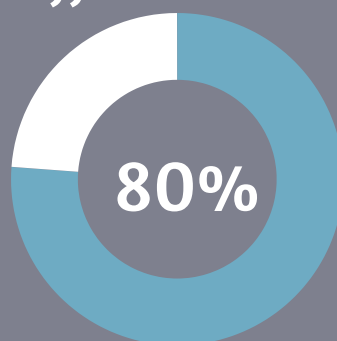

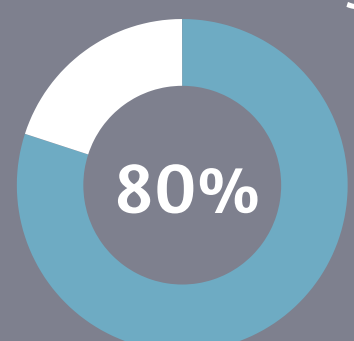
