TheseventhsessionoftheSta ndingCommitteeonInformation Technologies(SCIT)heldinJune2002,agreedtosetupaTaskForcetodiscuss therevisionofWIPOStandardST.10/C.InDecember2002,theTaskForce submitteditsreporttotheStandardsandDocumentationWorkingGroup (SDWG)oftheSCIT(seeAnnextoSCIT/SDWG/2/6).

The SDWG agreed that the Task Forcewould prepare a question naire on the maintenance of the Appendix to WIPOS tandard ST. 10/C, to be distributed by the International Bureau of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO), to industrial property of fices for completion.

Forthepurposesofthequestionnaire,twogroupsofOffices/Organizations have been defined: those appearing in the Appendix to WIPOS tandard ST. 10/C and those which do not. Attached as an Annex to this circularisthe

./. questionnairerelevanttoyourOffice/Organization.Alsoattached,for information,isacopyofthecurrentversionofWIPOStandardST.10/C.

Theprincipalobjectiveofthisexerciseis toimprovethequalityofpaten familydataandtoavoid confusioninthepresentationofpriorityapplication numbers. Therefore, aspartoftherevision of WIPO StandardST.10/C, the following revisions and updates should be considered:

(a) tocoverallthe member StatesoftheP arisConvention;

- (b) toincludethepresentationofapplicationnumbersofbothpatentsand utilitymodelsintheexamples ;
- (c) toincludeintheexamples presentedinWIPOStandardST.10/C the presentationofapplicationnumbersassignedby receiving regionalofficesofa particular countryinthose cases where there is no uniform system established for assigning application numbers among the different receiving regional of fices.

Also,thefollowingtworecommendations should be considered for inclusion in WIPO Standard ST.10/C:

- (a) are commendation to industrial property of fices to comply with the Standard when presenting the application number of a patent document in the notification of the first filing and in the certificate of priority ,
- (b) arec ommendationtoindustrialpropertyofficesto encourage and facilitatethecompliance, by applicants, with the standard when providing the priority application number in subsequent filings.

QUESTIONNAIRECONCERNINGTHEAPPENDIXTOWIPOSTANDARDST.10/C

INTRODUCTION

- 1. WithregardtotheTablesintheAppendix,aspointedoutintheprojectbrief (see AnnextodocumentSCIT/7/5) ,thefollowingproblemscurrentlyexist :
 - (a) Not all the member States of the Paris Conventionare covered

According to the survey conducted by the Task Force (see the Appendix 2 of the SCIT/SDWG/2/6), only 65 industrial property of fices (IPOs) are liste donthecurrent Tables of the Appendix to WIPOS tandard ST.10/Calthough the rearea bout 160 members of the Paris Convention. In addition, at least 44 IPOs are not listed or not appropriately listed on the Tables while their numbering systems are known. Then umbering systems of approximately 50 other members of the Paris Convention are unknown.

(b) Somenumbering systems on the Tables need to be revised or updated

TheremaybequiteafewIPOsthathave notrevisedorupdatedtheirpresentationson the Tables. In particular, there could be changes in the numbering system of certain countries after the year 2000.

(c) Informationonutilitymodelapplicationnumberingsystemisinsufficient

Asaresultof the above-mentioned survey ,13IPOs (marked w ith atriangle on the document) might not have reported their utility model application numbering systems. In addition, another 23IPOs (marked with a triangle and a question mark on the document) may have utility model application systems although their numbering systems have not yet been confirmed.

 $(d) \quad \textit{Information on numbering systems of IPOs with} \quad \textit{different (regional)} \ \textit{receiving} \\ \textit{offices is in sufficient}$

Somecountries may receive applications from several receiving regional offices but have notestablished a uniform system for assigning application numbers among the different receiving offices.

2. Unless "recommendedpresentationinabbreviatedformatasaprioritynumber "ofan IPOisknown,eachIPOthatsubsequently receivesanapplicationfromtheI POmight inconsistentlycitetheprioritynumberdatabasedonitsownjudgement. This causesa significantproblem whenprepar ing patentfamilydata. Therefore,moreIPOentriesinthe Appendixand/orupdatedinformationareextremelyimportant.

QUESTIONNAIRE

Informationforyourindustrialproperty OfficeisnotcurrentlylistedintheTablesof theAppendixtoWIPOStandardST.10/C althoughyouareamemberof the Paris Convention.
