Enclosed is updated information regarding US patents, reissued patents and Statutory Invention Registrations considered to be part of PCT Minimum Documentation for years 1920-1996.

The USPTO patent documents are numbered sequentially. Certain numbers, however, are not used due to some applications being withdrawn from issue. Lists of the unused numbers for patents, reissued patents and Statutory Invention Registrations can be found on the internet at the USPTO's website. The USPTO will be adding new "Pre-Grant Publication" documents to the Inventory of Patent Documents list in 2001 (see <u>http://www.uspto.gov/web/offices/dcom/olia/aipa/index.htm</u>). This will also change the ST.16 kind codes of our current patent documents. I would like to emphasize the importance of keeping this inventory up to date in the age of electronic exchange of patent documents (and particularly PCT minimum documentation).
