Madam, Sir,

This Circular is addressed to your office in its capacity as a receiving Office, International Searching Authority, International Preliminary Examining Authority and/or, designated or elected Office under the Patent Cooperation Treaty (PCT). It is also being sent to interested intergovernmental organizations as well as certain non-governmental organizations representing users of the PCT system.

This Circular concerns proposals for change to the Standard for the Electronic Filing and Processing of International Applications under the PCT (Annex F of the Administrative Instructions).

DESCRIPTION OF CHANGES

Proposed changes to Annex F and its appendices are set out in the following Proposal for Change (PFC) file (see http://www.wipo.int/pct/efiling_standard/en/pfc_files.htm):

 PCT/EF/PFC 11/001 (Addition of DTDs for RO/ISA/IPEA PCT forms), proposal by the European Patent Office, the Japan Patent Office and the United States Patent and Trademark Office

The proposed changes to Annex F and its appendices are to provide specifications designed to support the page current layouts of PCT forms, for the implementation of PCT forms in XML format.
