Submission of Information by Third Parties – Denmark

Rule 36 of the Order on Patents and Supplementary Protection Certificates¹ states that any person may provide information or observations of relevance for the examination of a patent application. No particular grounds are to be specified. However, the person who has submitted such information shall, where relevant, be notified of the additional opportunity to file an opposition if and when a patent is granted.
