

Eurasian Patent Office

The Eurasian Patent Convention (EAPC) provides a post-grant administrative revocation of the Eurasian patents. A Eurasian patent can be revoked by any person, other than the patent owner, by filing to the EAPO a notice of opposition within **three years** of the date of publication of information concerning the grant of a Eurasian patent and upon the payment of the prescribed fee.¹ The time limit for filing a notice of opposition may not be extended.² The right to file an opposition, lost due to failure to comply with the time limit for filing, may not be restored.³
