

Section 14, Article XIII of the Philippine Constitution provides that:

"SECTION 14. The State shall protect working women by providing safe and healthful working conditions, taking into account their maternal functions, and such facilities and opportunities that will enhance their welfare and enable them to realize their full potential in the service of the nation."


- Republic Act No. 9710 otherwise known as the Magna Carta for Women
- Republic Act No. 7192 otherwise known as Women in Development and Nation Building Act
- Republic Act No. 6725 otherwise known as an Act Strengthening the Prohibition on Discrimination Against Women with Respect to Terms and Conditions of Employment
- Republic Act No. 7877 otherwise known as the Anti Sexual Harassment Act
- Republic Act No. 9262 otherwise known as the "Anti-Violence Against Women and Their Children Act
- Republic Act No. 6949 declaring March 8 as the National Women's Day
- General Appropriations Act directs government agencies to formulate a GAD plan, the cost of which shall not be less than 5% of their yearly budget.


