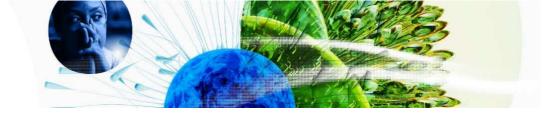
Global Innovation Index 2023



Berlin, Germany


Berlin is the fourth-ranked cluster, out of 9 German clusters, that falls within the top 100 S&T clusters in 2023. It filed 848 PCT applications and published 7,126 scientific articles, both per 1 million inhabitants over the last five years, making it the:

43rd largest science and technology cluster in 2023 (down one spot from 2022)

49th S&T cluster by intensity (relative to population density) in 2023 (up two spots from 2022)

31% of Berlin's PCT patent applications are filed in collaboration with other inventors, with Cologne, Munich and Frankfurt am Main emerging as the top collaborative locations.

72% of Berlin's scientific articles are published in collaboration with other organizations, with the top three collaborating locations being Cologne, Munich and Heidelberg–Mannheim.
