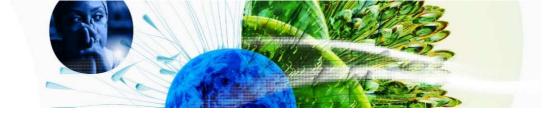

Lyon, France


Lyon is the second-ranked cluster, out of 3 French clusters, that falls within the top 100 S&T clusters in 2023. It filed 1,133 PCT applications and published 6,429 scientific articles, both per 1 million inhabitants over the last five years, making it the:

88th largest science and technology cluster in 2023 (down seven spots from 2022)

43rd S&T cluster by intensity (relative to population density) in 2023 (down three spots from 2022)

36% of Lyon's PCT patent applications are filed in collaboration with other inventors, with Paris, Grenoble and Cologne emerging as the top collaborative locations.

75% of Lyon's scientific articles are published in collaboration with other organizations, with the top three collaborating locations being Paris, Grenoble and Marseille.
